How to apply

The application form is available at www.internacional.ufpr.br and must be sent and signed by the origin institution.

The UFPR's International affairs office is in charge of application service.

-First Academic Semester (March-June):
Last Friday of October

-Second Academic Semester (August-November):
Last Friday of May

Course Registration



Shortly after you arrive at the University, please come to International Affair Office, for enrollment procedures. We will have the pleasure to register you at your undergraduate unit.

Bear in mind that the registration procedure is very important and you will not be able to attend classes until you get officially enrolled.

Documents required: passport copy and 2 x photo (size 3X4).

Visa (Immigration)



Most foreign exchange participants need a student visa, if they will stay for more than three months in the country. The exchange students shall apply for the visa before they come to Brazil, submitting the original acceptance document (letter or declaration signed by the Office for Foreign and International Affairs Director) to the Brazilian Consulates in their home countries. The student visa is valid for one year, but if any exchange student needs to renew it, it is necessary to go to Departamento de Polícia Federal – DPF (Federal Police Department) 30 days before expiration date..

Arriving in Brazil. all foreigners must register at DPF within 30 days. If a foreigner does not register according to the deadline a fine will be charged for each day of delay. At the moment of registration, an Identity Card for Foreigners will be issued.

The necessary documents for registration are:

- Form DPF 154 and copy of the used pages of the passport or Identity Card.
- 2 recent color photos 3 x 4cm on a white background;
- Original visa application form;
- GRU registration form and GRU foreigner card form.

The applicant must complete and download both GRU forms from the website www.dpf.gov.br using the codes 140082 and 140120, then pay the fee at the nearest bank,(R\$140,00) before going do DPF.

The International Affairs Office can assist you in case of doubt.

General Information - FOOD

UFPR offers a very low cost meal by means University Restaurant there are three restaurants located in different campus (one meal is R\$1,80). Besides the university restaurant, there is another moderate price alternative near the campus and throughout the city: Self-service restaurants – the person pays according to the food quantity he eats.

The price per kilo ranges from R\$ 10,00 to R\$ 20,00.

HOUSING



UFPR has not a foreign student residence but the Foreign Affairs Office keeps a list of available rooms to rent in different neighborhoods in the city of Curitiba . We would like to remind you that the office just indicates the available home stays.

All details should be dealt directly between the parts. If the student wishes to have enough time to decide he may stay in a hotel for a couple of days before choosing suitable accommodations. It is possible rent a furnished apartment and shares it with other students paying initially a three-month rent in advance.

ASSISTANCE TO FOREIGN STUDENTS



All foreign students **must have a valid health insurance during their stay**. If necessary, UFPR offers basic social assistance to foreign students through its Health Office in the Campus (CASA III). But remember: all students must have insurance valid for the period they will stay in Brazil.

CPF: CPF (Cadastro de Pessoas Físicas) is a necessary document if the student intends to open a bank account. It is a fiscal card provided by the Receita Federal – Ministério da Fazenda and is not compulsory for those who will stay in Brazil for less than 12 months. The necessary documents to get the CPF card are:

- An appropriate form which is available at Post Offices;
- The ID card or a passport for foreigners;
- An Attendance Declaration for those who are exchange students issued by the learning institution. The student must get this Declaration at International Affairs Office.

ASSISTANCE TO FOREIGN STUDENTS



STUDENT CARD

UFPR students are provided with the University student card so that they can prove to be a regular student at the University. It allows discounts in theatres, restaurants and transport.

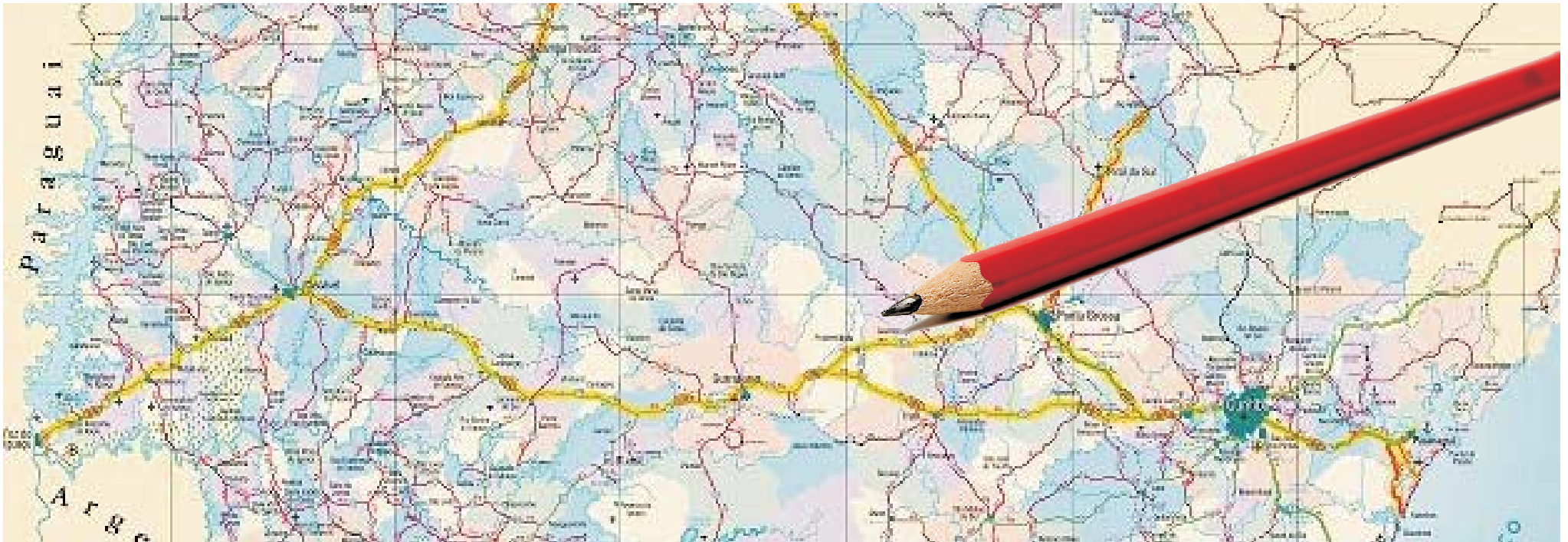
TRANSPORTATION

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

Currency, basically American dollar and Euro in travelers' checks or cash may be exchanged. The student must take the Identity Card and passport to exchange money. Banks are open Monday to Friday, from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. Foreign currency are not accepted in the market.

CLIMATE IN CURITIBA



Bring Sweaters, raincoat because Curitiba has a Maritime Temperate climate or Subtropical highland. Located in Southern Brazil, the somewhat humid city lies in a Subtropic zone. Located in a plateau and the flat terrain with flooded areas contribute to its mild and damp winter, with average temperatures of 13 °C (55 °F) in the coldest month, falling slightly below 0 °C (32 °F), on the coldest days. During summer, the average temperature is around 21°C (70 °F), but gets above 32 °C (90 °F) on hot days. Heat waves during winter and cold waves during summer are not uncommon, and even within a single day there can be great variation, a typical feature of subtropical climates. Several factors contribute to the climate's variable nature.

Distances : Sao Paulo: 400km (6 h bus, 50' Fly) - Rio de Janeiro: 800 km (11h bus, 1h Fly) - Florianópolis: 300km (4h bus) - Buenos Aires (1.300 km, 26h bus, 2h fly) - Montevideo (1.200 km, 24 h bus, 1h 50'Fly)
